An accurate diagnosis is a critical first step in helping people who are experiencing memory loss, depression, or behavior problems. Using the latest diagnostic advances, a team consisting of a Geriatric Psychiatrist, social workers and nurses assess individuals on an outpatient basis. The team then discusses the diagnosis and recommends treatment with families and caregivers so they can best assist their loved ones.

 **Support Groups and Education** - Our Recharge Community Nurse Educator is involved with several programs on the Eastern Shore to help patients and their caregivers receive care that is focused on the best available treatments while maintaining patient dignity. We also offer an educational website for caregivers, www.alzcast.org.

 **Short-Stay Evaluation** - Our residential Short-Stay Evaluation provides more in-depth information to aid those who need expert diagnosis and guidance. Those enrolled undergo a comprehensive evaluation of their physical and mental condition. Caregivers also receive advice and training to help them better meet their loved ones' needs in any setting.
